Last season, Gammon Parks Racing walked away with the second biggest trophy in the point standings for the Miller Tire/BFGoodrich Thunder division along with other end of season awards. Optimism was running rapid at the 2008 Awards Banquet in January and with some recent announcements from the newly named Boulton Racing Team, the season looks even brighter than 2008's four car effort!

Some may ask who Boulton is and what connection he has to the newly rebranded team? "He's my accountant," Ross says about Timothy Ray Boulton in a team release on their website. "I've been working with him since 2007 and got him excited this winter about getting involved with racing at Scotia Speedworld and with that comes Boulton Racing team."

Not only will this year see a new name, but also changes within the team that will see BRT expand to ten cars under a "self ownership" system. Ross explained that "the set up this year is quite different from 2008 where we owned all the cars that were entered. In 2009 each driver owns their own car, however they accept being part of our team by taking on major and minor sponsorship opportunities that BRT offer them."

Another big offseason signing was that of the 2008 Champion of the Miller Tire/BFGoodrich Thunder class, Derek MacCallum. "We're very excited to have Derek's knowledge for the upcoming season," Parks added about the signing of the multi-time Thunder race winner.
